

SUMMER LITERACY CHALLENGE 2023

“Reading books aloud to children stimulates their imagination and expands their understanding of the world. It helps them develop language and listening skills and prepares them to understand the written word.”

The Family Partnership Center is having a summer literacy challenge. For 6 weeks record all the books your child reads or that you are reading to them! Ms. Sarah has also picked a theme each week. Try and read a story from the theme and use the provided questions to have a fun conversation about the book! You can bring your reading log into playgroup each week or email a picture of your log to Ms. Sarah. There will be a prize at the end of the 6 weeks for every child who participates as well as grand prize drawing!

Grand Prize Drawing:

Each child's name will be entered once for every 5 books. So if you read 25 books this summer their name will be submitted 5 times! The grand prize drawing will take place on 8/16.

We understand that it is sometimes difficult to juggle older kids with new schooling requirements and responsibilities, but we want to be sure our youngest learners are still encouraged to read as well. We encourage reading at ANY TIME during your day, including in the morning while eating breakfast, while the kids are playing in the bathtub, while sitting in the car in the driveway or while waiting outside the pharmacy, laying on the couch or in bed before nap or bedtime, laying on a blanket out in your yard enjoying some late summer sun and more.
